PHSE

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What makes a good friend? We will look at the qualities that makes a good friend and how to resolve differences.

What helps me to be happy? Understanding the connection between our actions and the feelings of ourselves and others

History

We will be consolidating our knowledge we have learnt in previous terms.

Science

Plants – We will be investigating the changes in seasons since Winter. We will also look at different trees and plants. We will be naming different trees, plants and flowers. Finally, we will be looking how to label a plant using; roots, leaves, stem and petal and looking at the job for each part.

Computing

We will be developing our skills in using Scratch to develop a character and make it move.

Year 1

English

In English our first class text will be **'Goldilocks** and the 3 bears'. From this text we will be writing a recount of what happened in the Bear's house.

Our second class text will be **'Snail and the Wale'**. From this we will be writing our own narratives.

Maths

In maths we will be looking at time to the hour and half past the hour. We will be investigating position and direction and writing our own maps to navigate our way through school. Finally, we will be consolidating all of our knowledge. This includes topics such as number, fractions, shape, weight and length.

RE

What makes places scared? Pupils will have the opportunity to act as detectives answering their own questions about places of worship, what they are used for and their significance in the local community.

Geography

Where am I? We will study the basic physical and human geography of the local area, and learn how where we live specifically connects to the wider region we live in.

Where on Earth? We will look at a wider global context, focusing on the number and locations of the continents, oceans and general understanding of different areas of the world

DT

We will be exploring preparing fruit and vegetables. We will be looking at a healthy plate and designing our own. We will then look at how we can chop, peel or slice different fruit and vegetables. Finally we will evaluate our learning.

Art

Our artist focus this term is **Pete McKee.** We will be developing a range of artistic skills such as using poster paint, colour mixing, collage and oil pastels.

Music

In music we will be using by the sea as a focus. We will be introduced to the inter-related dimensions of music pitch and tempo in a meaningful way. We will learn how to identify high and low notes and how to compose a simple tune, while exploring some different instruments along the way. Pupils will have the opportunity to investigate how tempo changes help tell a musical story and make music more exciting.

Phonics

In phonics we will be continuing to learn and practise our phase 5 sounds, tricky words and high frequency words. We will be aiming to apply our new sounds in our independent writing.

PE

At AJA, the pupils receive specialist teaching from PE teachers based at Aston. In PE we will developing our orienteering skills. We will also be continuing to develop our locomotion skills and exploring different ways we can move. We will also be developing our fitness and balance skills.
