PHSE

Our focus this term is on health. We will learn how to look after our bodies by eating and sleeping well. Children will learn how to keep their teeth in good condition and why this is important.

History

Y3 will study Ancient Egypt. The will learn about the key features of Ancient Egyptian society before considering the achievements of the Egyptians.

Science

Pupils will explore light and how our eyes use light to see. We will learn about how shadows are formed. In our second unit, nutrition, skeleton and muscles, children will identify how we should keep ourselves healthy, looking at the needs of our diet and the effect on our bodies.

Computing



We will be learning to use create interactive, moving characters using coding. Children will learn to explain how simple algorithms work.

Year 3

curriculum A

English

Our class text for the summer term will be 'Flat Stanley'. We will begin by writing a character description of Flat Stanley using Y3 grammar and punctuation. We will then move on to learn about the features of a letter before writing our own Flat Stanley adventure.

Maths

This term we will be focussing on the following units:

Finding the perimeter of rectangles

Equivalent fractions and fractions of a number of objects/ shape

Finding double and half of two digit numbers

Time – including duration of events

Multiplication of 2 digit and one digit numbers.

Addition and subtraction of 4 digit numbers

RE

We will be learning what different religions believe about God focussing on Christianity, Islam and Hinduism.

Geography

We will be linking our class text 'Flat Stanley' to identify countries on a world map in relation to where we live.

DT

In this unit pupils will be learning about shell structure products. They will explore a range of products, including packaging, and identify the purpose of the shell structure; for protecting, presenting, or containing.

Art

Our artist study this term will be on Paul Caulfield. Linking with our science unit, children will learn all about the artist and how he used light to create effects in his artwork.

Music

The unit for this term is called 'Gift of the Nile'. Children will learn to identify the pitch and rhythm of written notes before moving on to create their own compositions using musical notation.

Modern Foreign Languages – French

We will learn the words for breakfast foods and drinks using 'je mange/bois'. We will then move on to learn about prices using Euros, using role play to order items in a café.

PE

Our PE unit this term is athletics. Children will practise a range of sports including javelin, relay races, long jump and hurdles in readiness to take part in sports day.
