

PSHE

In PSHE this term we will be focussing on 'How can we manage risk in different places?'

We will do this by exploring how children should be aware of risk and danger in their surroundings and how to keep safe at all times including online.

RE

The 2 units of RE we will cover this term are 'What can we learn from religions about deciding what is right and wrong?' and 'Why do people pray?'.

These key questions will be explored in many religions and faiths to develop our understanding of some of the practices in modern

History

Our History focus for the remainder of the year will cover Viking and Anglo-Saxon Struggle for England. We will research who the Viking's were, some of their traditions and compare their lives to the Romans who we studied in the Autumn Term.

Geography

Our Geography will be a place study this term. The location in the UK we will be studying will be kept a secret however we will use the map of the United Kingdom and identify significant features of this UK city or town.



Science

We will cover States of Matter and Sound this term.

States of matter will look at solid, liquids and gases and the Sound unit will explore vibrations, how we hear, pitch and link to the music the Vikings made. .

English

This term we will be using our year 4 writing skills to write a non-chronological report based on an event from our new text.

Our new class text is written by the author Cressida Cowell and has some character names such as; Dogsbreath, Hiccup and Berk. I wonder what our text could be ?

DT

In DT this term we will link it to the History Unit where we will research, evaluate, design and produce a Viking money pouch.

Maths

In the first half of this term in maths we will be learning to; find lines of symmetry, area and perimeter of 2D shapes, recap rounding numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000, introduction to angles and translations.

Alongside this we will be continuing to focus on mental maths strategies to help us speed up our skills.

Computing

This term we will cover a unit of scratch and using the basic features of excel.

Scratch is a programme where we will revisit skills learnt in previous years and build on our knowledge.

Art

In Art this term we will exploring Camille Pissarro and creating a cityscape linked to our place study in Geography. This will be using another media that the pupils will develop over the unit.

Music – linked to Viking Saga Songs

The children will learn to sing different styles of songs considering rhythm such as syncopation and repeating patterns using arpeggios. They will move on to learn about duration of notes and how pauses can create effect in music.

Modern Foreign Languages – French

This term the pupils will be learning to name breakfast foods and drinks, using je mange/je bois, by creating a breakfast survey, and prices using numbers up to 30 by creating a café menu and taking part in café role plays.

PE

PE will focus on athletics and racket activities this half term and we are very lucky to receive specialist teaching from Miss Murray for PE. This term will also see us prepare for Sports Day.
