RSHE

In RSHE the children will be learning how to keep their bodies healthy. They will also be exploring relationships and who their friends are both inside and outside of school.

History

In History the children will be learning about
Remembrance Day and why some people in Britain
choose to wear poppies. We will study the significant
individual Edith Cavell and how she contributed to
national and international achievements.

Science

Gross motor and core strength is the starting to ensure good posture ready for the children to develop their fine motor skills. We will continue to help the children move in different ways and building their core strength.

Computing

In computing the children will be learning about 'Technology around us'. The children will learn to identify the main features on a computer. They will also learn how to use a computer sensibly.

Year 1



English

In English this term our reading into writing texts will be 'Rumble in the Jungle' and 'Room on the Broom'. We will be learning about different jungle animals and write a riddle. We will also write a set of instructions on how to make our own magical broomstick!

Alongside this the children will be learning to add exclamation and question marks into their writing.

Maths

In maths we will be about place value within 10. We will be using Dienes to identify how many tens and ones are in numbers. We will then move onto addition and subtraction in Autumn 2. We will use part whole models to support our understanding.

RE

In RE we will be learning about what Christians and Jews believe. We will be learning about different religious stories and how they make a difference to people's lives.

Geography

In Geography we will be recognising where our school is on a map and look at local features around it. We will be discussing where we live in relation to the school and



DT

In DT we will explore a range of structures in their local environment. We will use construction kits and different materials to explore building structures and will learn how to strengthen and stiffen them. We will use our learning to generate our own ideas for building a structure for purpose.

We will use knowledge and skills from their learning to create structures before evaluating them.

Art

In Art we will be looking at David Hockney and producing a piece of work to show seasonal changes.

Music

In music our unit is 'Animal Mad'. In this unit the children will use their bodies and instruments to listen and respond to classical music that represent animals. Within this unit the children will learn and perform a song as a class ensemble, composing a short section of music with a focus on dynamics and tempo.

Phonics

In phonics we will begin learning phase 5 sounds, tricky words, and high frequency words. We will be aiming to apply our new sounds in our independent writing.

We will also be exposing the children to alien words during our daily phonics sessions in preparation for the Phonics Screening in Summer 2. Please speak to your child's class teacher for any questions or further information.

PE

In Y1 the children's PE day will be on a Thursday. The children will be developing their skills in Object Control. This will include developing their skills in rolling a ball, underarm throwing, throwing and catching, and football control. The children will also be developing their Locomotion skills such as running, skipping, jumping, and hopping.

We look forward to sharing our wonderful learning with you from our first term here at AJA.

Home Learning

Spellings, times tables and reading are our non-negotiables.

We also have Edshed for the children to practice their weekly spellings at home. The children should have individual log ins in there reading diaries.
