Positive Feedback and General Comments

We are delighted that 100% of our parents/carers agree 'their children are happy and feel safe at Aughton Junior Academy', 'their children are taught well and are making good progress' and 'that we expect children to do their best'.

All our staff work incredibly hard, and it was a delight to see that all our parents and carers agreed that the academy is well led and managed, any concerns they raise are dealt with promptly and that they communicate well with parents and carers.

Outcomes from the Questionnaire

100% of parents and carers who responded think this is a good school and are proud their child attends it and would recommend Aughton Junior Academy to other parents.

100% of parents and carers who responded think the school is a friendly and welcoming place.

100% of parents and carers who responded said their child is happy and feels safe at Aughton Junior Academy.

100% of parents and carers who responded said that reading is important to Aughton, the academy encourage their child to read regularly and 96% said their child enjoys books from the reading scheme.

100% of parents and carers who responded said the academy is well led and managed, deals effectively with bullying and responds well to concerns that they raise. 94% of parents said that the academy ensures pupils are well behaved.

100% of parents and carers who responded said that there is a good range of subjects available, their child's wellbeing is supported, their child is taught how to stay safe online and that the academy supports their child's wider development.

98% of parents and carers responded that they receive valuable information about their child's progress and that the academy encourages good attendance.

96% of parents and carers who responded said that the academy communicates well with parents and carers.
