History

English

From this we shall produce a biography, narrative, persuasive letter and 2 more independent pieces.

Geography

4 and 6 figure grid references, compass directions and locating human and physical features on maps.

Healthy Humans - children to learn about the inner workings of the human body.

Evolution – Darwin's theory of how animals have adapted to life on Earth

DT

Structures – Understanding how framed structures have developed over time, recognising how they have been made and the materials used.

Computing

Internet communication – Children understand how computers speak to one another.

Maths

Place value, formal addition & subtraction, including decimals, short & long multiplication/division, multiplying and dividing by powers 10/100/1000, Factors, multiples, prime numbers, square and cubed numbers BIDMAS.

Art

Marc Chagall – Children to recognise important artists throughout time. Children to develop their own opinions on their work.
